Terms and Conditions

How does it work?

- You can bring in during regular opening hours, in the afternoon after 1 PM. Preferably not on Saturdays.
- Your items are carefully checked upon during contribution, Quinnie's decides what is taken.
- We register you as a seller and your items in our system.
- You can log into the system to see the status of your items, the return date and your actual balance. Please note: e-mails from the system often end up in the Spam box.
- You will receive 40% of the sales price of your items.
- You can spend the accumulated credit in our store, or we pay it out every quarter.
- Quinnie's determines the sales price per item and can also increase or decrease this sales price in the meantime (max 50%).
- Items will hang in the store for 10-12 weeks, afterwards it will be taken to charity.
- Quinnie's reserves the right to keep items in store for a longer period of time.
- Any items left behind but not taken will be kept for a maximum of 1 week, because we do not have enough store capacity. If you won't pick them up on time, they go to charity.
- Pick up your stock that is not sold? That is possible of course. Please pass by before the return date (which you can find in your personal account) and collect your items yourself.
- Would you like to pick up what has not been sold? That is possible. Then come by before the return date expires and collect all the items from the store yourself. Unfortunately, it takes us too much time to sort this out per customer and we don't have room to keep everything in the back office. Keep an eye on the return date in your personal account and make a note in your agenda if necessary.

What do we take in?

- We are happy with your designer clothes in sizes 50 to 146 (0 to 10 years). Check the brands we love below on this page.
- We find quality very important. Ask yourself: would I buy it? Has it been washed, wrinkle free, without stains, holes and are all buttons still attached? Perfect. Also, please check the zippers.
- Please select which items qualify from home and bring that selection with you.
- Unique vintage items and newer Zara and H&M clothes are also very welcome. Zeeman and Primark unfortunately aren't.
- Handmade, we like that very much. If it's still of this time and of good quality, it's also very welcome.
- In addition to clothing, Quinnie's also offers high-quality (wooden) toys, balance bikes, children's books, wraps and sleeping bags.
- Shoes are also welcome, only if of excellent condition and cleaned.
- The intake of spring and summer clothing is from February to July
- The intake of autumn and winter clothing is from August to January
- Finally, we understand that it can be disappointing if we do not accept items. From experience we now know which items are wanted. This may have to do with color/style/fit, etc. and is not always easy to explain. Due to limited space in our store, the labor-intensive process of processing and because we want to remain attractive to our customers, we are critical. Are you not sure of want to check upfront?
